2 Corinthians 5:14-21 NLT

1. What's one thing from last weekend's message that you hope we talk about as a group?
2. When was there a time in your life where someone stood in the gap for you? Or a third party was invited that helped you get past a difficult time? Describe what life change/actions occurred afterwards.
3. In reading 2 Corinthians 5:14-21, what thoughts do you have that you feel need to be discussed that may or may not have been included in Pastor Terry's message?

b. Pastor Terry directed our attention to the passage that reads, "And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him." As a group, discuss what this means in our personal lives but also as a home group?

Challenge for the Church: In reading 2 Corinthians 5:20 NLT, "So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, 'Come back to God!'" How is God able to make his "appeal" through us?

b. Where in our life are we able to make this appeal? Discuss as a group some practical ways we can make this happen.

Closing in prayer: Close in prayer this week as a group asking for the Holy Spirit to lead us to places where we are able to be ambassadors of God's reconciliation in the world we live in.
