1 Samuel 17:1-50 NIV

1.) Two weeks ago, Pastor Terry spoke on S.O.A.P (Scripture, Observation, Application, and Prayer). How did that go this past week? Are there any observations or prayers that you would like to share with the group this week?

b.) Make some S.O.A.P. journal entries for 1 Samuel 17:1-50 NIV and share.

2.) Pastor Terry spoke about how we often don't notice the giants around us and even more specifically, when we do see them, we think we don't have what it takes to overcome them. Speak on a few giants that you have noticed and overcame and speak on a few giants that you notice but don't know where to start to overcome them.

b. How, as a home group, can we come together to overcome some of these giants? Take this time to also have a conversation about the "lions and bears" you have already overcome that may have prepared you for the giants. (Illnesses, health of a child, loss, past hurt or broken relationship, divorce, loss of job, etc.)

3. Pastor Terry challenged us to walk your neighborhood at the same time each day to take notice of your neighbors and to intentionally ask how they are doing. What are some other ways that we can intentionally get to know our neighbors? Some examples can be to add them on Facebook, write encouraging cards to the eight houses around you, have a neighborhood BBQ when the concerns for COVID is over, and/or ask those you come in contact with how you can be praying for them. (Leaders take note and ask how we can hold each other accountable to some of these ideas.)

b.) Share with your home group some prayer concerns for your neighbors and take the last 10 minutes of group and pray for each other's neighborhoods and ask God to move His Spirit in a way that will lead you to see some giants in your own neighborhood.
